Companies have several options for tackling their climate commitments (for example: improved energy efficiency, purchasing green PPAs, building their own renewable energy projects, buying carbon offsets ..). This panel will examine the benefits of pursuing an investment approach in renewables – designed to yield financial returns together with the accretion of environmental attributes for carbon neutrality goals. This investment approach has been used to engage suppliers and tackle a company's Scope 3 GHG emissions.

Additionally, the panel will cover broader opportunities to connect climate and social goals to a company's financing and highlight the process for issuing Sustainability Bonds and Sustainability Linked Loans. CAPITAL STRUCTURE AND ALLOCATION STRATEGY

The session will provide an overview of how Treasury practitioners formulate and implement capital structure and allocation strategies. Selecting an optimal capital structure involves balancing many considerations including the relative cost advantage of debt, risk of too much leverage and change in financial flexibility. Amid fast-changing market conditions managing a firm's weighted average cost of capital, leverage and liquidity require vigilance and collaboration. Capital allocation strategy encompasses growing the business and returning capital to shareholders. While priorities evolve during a firm's life cycle, establishing guidelines for M&A, reinvestment and return of capital will help in the capital allocation decision-making process. Panelists will also discuss how capital structure and allocation can impact total shareholder return.




